Three times a year, Oasis For Girls hosts Career Night to provide our girls with the opportunity to meet women in various professions and learn about the challenges and successes they have experienced in their career paths. We will have two amazing women to give a short 5 minute "job talk" to inspire Oasis girls and help kick-off our networking session. A semi-structured networking activity will follow our dynamic speakers to simulate what true networking looks like in the "real" world.

HOW IT WORKS



We are seeking 15 women with at least five years of professional experience to serve as volunteer mentors. Our girls typically enjoy talking to and hearing from women in the following industries such as: technology, fashion, culinary, finance, education, nonprofit/social justice, event planning, arts/culture, healthcare, and media/communications. Women in other unique/interesting lines of work are also welcome.

In addition to sharing their wisdom and experience with our girls, Career Night Mentors make a gift of \$250 to Oasis For Girls. The funds are used*

for additional career exploration activities including field trips to local universities and businesses. *This donation may be covered by a volunteer's employer. We are also accepting donations to help underwrite the participation of women from traditionally lower income professions such as the arts and nonprofit. Because we seek to work with volunteers who have shared experiences with our girls, women of color and/or from

low-income backgrounds are encouraged to participate.
